The [Tūpuna Maunga Authority](#) (TMA) is offering an annual \$10,000 funding pool to support students who wish to undertake research on the Tūpuna Maunga.

Research project proposals must take into consideration:

- the spiritual, ancestral, cultural, customary, and historical significance of the Tūpuna Maunga to Ngā Mana Whenua o Tāmaki Makaurau
- what the work will potentially impact e.g: the whenua, cultural values, the public
- Researchers should aim to provide value to the Tūpuna Maunga, enhancing the mana of these taonga tuku iho (treasures to be handed down).

If you are a successful applicant for this scholarship, you will be granted a permit that outlines the conditions you will be required to meet.

All scholarship applications must be submitted via this online application form.
